

Supporting the community

In 2018 our Club donated \$340,710 to organisations that make a positive impact to our community by tackling key issues such as homelessness, domestic violence, aged care, early childhood care and community sports, to name a few.

City Tatts is proud to be part of the Club Grants program, consisting of more than 500 registered clubs which gave over \$100 million to deserving community causes in 2018/19 and over \$1 billion since the scheme began. As clubs are not-for-profit organisations, the wClub Grants program ensures that surplus funds are given to those most in need in the community.

Category 1 grants support community welfare and social services; community development; employment assistance activities; community health services; and projects aimed at improving the living standards of low income and disadvantaged people. In 2018, City Tattersalls donated \$305,633 to Category 1 recipients and \$35,077 to Category 2 recipients, which were mostly sporting clubs.

City Tatts supports program to reconnect mothers and children

Lou's Place opened in Kings Cross in 1999 as a community based daytime refuge providing facilities and case management for women who are in crisis, homeless, feeling isolated or needing support. Since then, the centre has had more than 60,000 visits from women in need.

City Tatts provided \$20,000 in 2018 to help launch and fund the ongoing work of Always Mum, one of the organisation's key programs. This initiative was created to help mothers re-establish or improve relationships with their children placed in foster care. The 10-week Always Mum program includes case management support and advocacy; legal education and advice; assistance dealing with Family and Community Services; a professional photograph and the opportunity for the mother to record a story for her child/children.

Executive manager of Lou's Place, Nicole Yade, said around 30 mothers had already completed the course and many of those were well on the way to rebuilding relationships with their children.

"The Always Mum program is all about helping mothers by enabling them to start re-connecting with their children in a safe way. It is making a difference, but the delicate process of rebuilding the bond between mother and child takes time. The generous donation from the City Tattersalls Club helped us get the program off the ground last year and in a position to run it on an ongoing basis," she said.
